Change of reconciliation participant agent

The following networks are embedded network operators and are therefore required to be a certified reconciliation participant in accordance with clause 15.38 of part 15.

The networks below use **Meridian Energy (MERX)** as their primary Reconciliation Participant agent. MERX in turn subcontracts gathering and storing meter data, creation and management of HHR volume information, and provision of submission information for reconciliation to **Bluecurrent Assets NZ Limited (Bluecurrent)** formerly known as AMS, **EDMI NZ Limited (EDMI)** and **EMS**.

From 1 August 2024 the primary reconciliation participant agent for the networks in the table below will change from MERX to **The Embedded Network Company Ltd (TENR)**. The subcontractor agents are set out in the table below and will not change:

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The change of the primary agent to TENR is considered to be a material change under Clause 8(1) of Schedule 15.1. In accordance with the EA's email dated 3 October 2019, this letter is intended as an alternative to a full material change audit where a change of agent will occur.
