ER-1407	03/09/2024	An output file name, from a request submitted using the batch interface often uses a standard file naming convention in combination with the request file name to generate the output file name. For example a LIST file request named "myRequestForICPData.txt" would have a response file of "LIS equestForICPData.txt". the file naming convention assists with matching input file with their response.  Depending on the request file, and if the request file is less than the standard response name the file name can cause an invalid file name to be generated	Complete
